



At Immaculate Parish we take very seriously the safety of all parishioners and the community and are following guidelines mandated by our Bishop. Effective immediately, Bishop Medley has suspended all public celebrations of the Eucharist at parishes in the Owensboro Diocese. **There will be no daily or Sunday Mass at Immaculate through Palm Sunday (April 5th), at which time the situation will be re-evaluated. All parish events and meetings are canceled until further notice.**

The Church will be open daily from 7am to 5pm if you would like to pray and spend time with Jesus. Prayer books that include the Stations of The Cross and many Catholic devotionals will be available for anyone who wishes to pray privately. Any prayer book that you use should be put in your pocket or purse and taken with you – please do not return these to the basket.

During this time, the **Sacrament of Penance** will be celebrated on an individual basis. To maintain the best practice of social distancing, **Fr. John will be located in the Priest's Sacristy on Wednesdays from 4pm-5pm and on Saturday mornings from 8am – 9:30am to hear individual confessions.** If the Sacristy door is closed upon your arrival, please wait and pray until that person finishes with Fr. John.

We will continue to provide a church bulletin weekly.
