

Mass Guideline Reminders and Information as of August 6, 2020

Please note that these guidelines are subject to change as needed for the safety of our parish. The governor's newest announcement on July 21 does not change the following guidelines in place at Immaculate.

(We were already requiring face mask and 6ft distancing.)

Mass seating will be "First Come, First Seated" and doors will open 30 minutes prior to Mass.

-If you are sick, or have been sick, or exposed to someone with COVID 19, please do not enter the Church. If you are considered in the High-Risk category, please worship from home.

- **Church Entry**—Everyone should enter from the front church doors. The South Side door entry will only be available to those with special mobility needs. The North door will remain locked at this time. Please park accordingly. We will exit the church starting with the back pews first, so please remain in your pew.
- The Church is now allowed to host 50% of its capacity, however, while maintaining a 6 feet of distance for those in pews the capacity number really doesn't change. This allows us a capacity of approx. 213 people. We will be allowing seating in every other pew. Pews that are open for seating will be marked with a pew bow and taped off in 2 foot sections so you can see how much space you need between families. A trained usher will be in church to assist with seating
- Everyone over the age of 3 must wear a mask. **We ask that you bring your own mask. We will have a limited supply on hand if someone arrives without one.** Hand Sanitizer Stations are available at every church entrance.
- Offertory donations will be collected with the poles.
- Holy Communion will be given in the hand only (no gloved hands). Please wear your facemask, after receiving the Holy Eucharist step to the side and consume. Those in single-file communion line should adhere to the 6ft markings on the floor.
- The Church and bathrooms will be cleaned and sanitized after each Mass.
